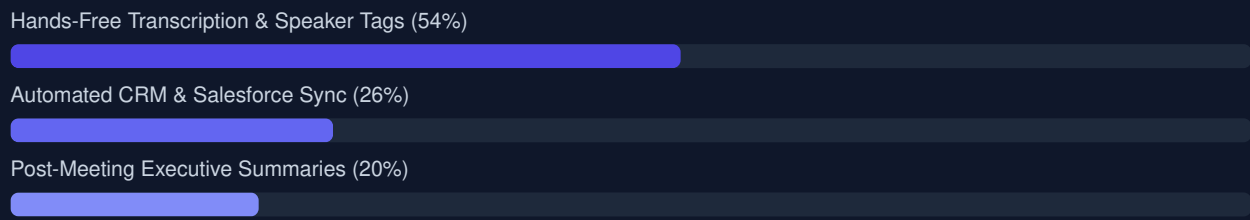

Q4: How does "Vibe Coding" with Cursor work for people who don't code?

"Vibe Coding" allows non-programmers to describe desired software features in plain English. The AI agent generates the necessary code, sets up file structures, installs dependencies, and resolves errors autonomously, enabling non-technical users to build functional web applications.

Q5: Are these AI tools safe regarding personal and company privacy?

Caution is necessary on public free tiers, as default settings may use inputs to train underlying models. For sensitive personal or corporate data, it is recommended to use Enterprise plans or platforms offering strict zero-data-retention guarantees.
